January: At the meeting, show any past projects you might have just finished. In your sewing room, be working on Charm School (page 33).


February: At the meeting, show Charm School. In your sewing room, be working on Pint Size (page 37).

Please mark your calendars for our first Quilt Bingo which will be held at the Fearless Fire Company in Allentown on **Sunday, September 10, 2023**.
