February 6, 2024- David Sirota will present his lecture, "Quilt While You're Ahead" on Zoom. This is a hybrid meeting. Members will gather at Calvary Baptist, weather permitting.

February 17, 2024 - WORKSHOP - David returns to teach his "Collide-o-scope" quilt technique. Zoom at home only. 9:00 AM – 4:00 PM with an hour break for lunch. The cost is \$40 for each participant. 
At our December in-person only meeting, 36 members attended including 3 visitors. Visitors were a husband, a sister & a daughter of our members. We are a family of quilters!


