

Crazy Quilters' Quilt Guild Tour de Quilts 2021 – Friendship Star



For the Friendship Star you will need:

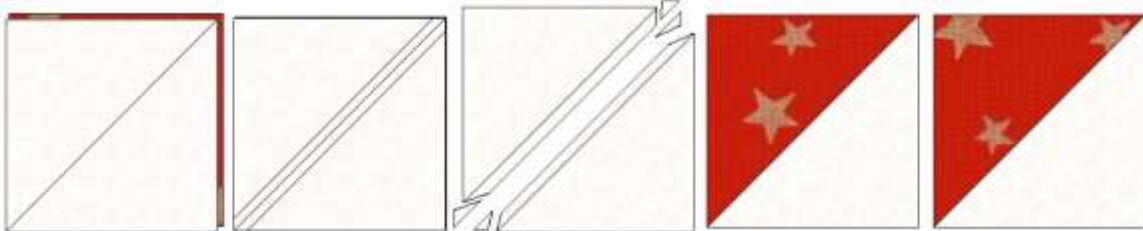
From your darker color, cut two $4 \frac{7}{8}$ inch squares and one $4 \frac{1}{2}$ inch square.

From your Background, cut two $4 \frac{7}{8}$ inch squares and four $4 \frac{1}{2}$ inch squares.

Step one: Place a dark square and a background block right sides together. Carefully draw a line down the center, corner to corner, diagonally across the block. (This will be a cutting line when you are finished.)

Step two: If you have a true $\frac{1}{4}$ inch foot on your machine, you can sew on either side of this drawn line. If not, you will have to draw a second line on either side, exactly $\frac{1}{4}$ inch from the first line. This will be your sewing line.

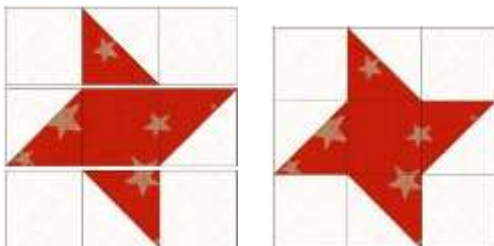
Step three: After you have sewn on your sewing line, $\frac{1}{4}$ inch on either side of your corner to corner to line, you will cut this square in half on your cutting line. You will now have two diagonal half-squares, which should measure exactly $4 \frac{1}{2}$ inches.



Step four: Make two sets like this. Pay close attention to the direction your diagonal half-square is



Step five: Make one set like this. Again, be very careful of the direction your diagonal half-squares.



Now you can assemble your block and it should look like this. Make sure your star points are all going in the same direction as the pattern. It should measure $12 \frac{1}{2}$ inches exactly!

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
