
Crazy Quilters' Quilt Guild Tour de Quilts 2021 - Hour Glass

For the Hour Glass block you will need:

From your dark (blue) 4 1/2 inch square and one 4 7/8 inch square

From your medium (gold) cut four 4 1/2 inch squares


From your background (white) cut one 4 7/8 inch square and two 4 1/2 inch square



Place a dark and a background 4 7/8 inch square right sides together. Carefully draw a line down the center, corner to corner, diagonally across the block. (This will be a cutting line when you are finished.) Now if you have a true 1/4 inch foot on your machine, you can sew on either side of this drawn line. If not, you will have to draw a second line on either side, exactly 1/4 inch from the first line. This will be your sewing line. After you have sewn on your sewing line, 1/4 inch on either side of your corner to corner to line, you will cut this square in half on your cutting line. You will now have two diagonal half-squares, which should measure exactly 4 1/2 inches.













Now you can assemble your block.




Make two sets like this.

Finish your block following this diagram. Your block should measure 12 1/2 inches.
